Greetings! On behalf of the entire cast and crew of *Guys and Dolls*, I would like to welcome you to our 60th anniversary of presenting musicals.

Sixty years ago (almost to the day) Community Players ventured into new territory and presented its very first musical — which just happened to be *Guys and Dolls*. I often wonder if those brave individuals who took the chance to move forward with a musical had any idea of the legacy that their decision led to. Since that time, we have produced over 100 musicals and we are so excited to be able to bring this timeless classic to life again for you today.

I am especially attached to this show because my parents were in the original cast in 1964. (I was too young and stayed home with a babysitter). My father played Arvide and my mother was in the mission band, and both continued to be very active members and performers over the years. Gas was \$.27 a gallon, cars cost on average \$1,500 to \$2,000, a loaf of bread was \$.12, and the average annual salary was \$3,300. Hard for us to imagine. But even in the 1950's the everlasting story of good and bad, boys and girls, and love and hate is ever present, and as always, love conquers all. So join us for an evening or afternoon of music, singing, dancing and laughter as we venture back into the 1950's.

As with every Community Player's production, there are SO MANY people behind the scenes who make it possible to bring you quality theatre. I wish to thank the entire cast, crew, orchestra, and production staff for all the hours, energy, and support they have given me. They are the unsung heroes, those who went far above and beyond to make this dream of mine a reality. I am so grateful to be surrounded by so much talent. And a special thanks to our patrons and advertisers for their continued support.

Synopsis

Set in the colorful world of New York City in the mid-20th century, the romantic and funny *Guys and Dolls* is populated with gangsters and gamblers, missionary dolls, and scantily clad showgirls. Gambler, Nathan Detroit tries to find the cash to set up the biggest craps game in town while the authorities breathe down his neck; meanwhile, his girlfriend and nightclub performer, Adelaide, laments that they've been engaged for 14 years. Nathan turns to fellow gambler, Sky Masterson, for the dough, and Sky ends up chasing the straight-laced missionary, Sarah Brown. As a result, *Guys and Dolls* takes us from the heart of Times Square to the cafes of Havana, Cuba, and even into the sewers of New York City, but eventually everyone ends up right where they belong. *Guys and Dolls* is one of the great musical scores in the history of American theatre.
